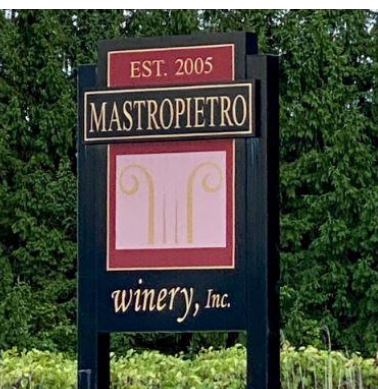

SIM Racing – Visit www.PCASimRacing.org for latest. Soon the National team will be launching a zone and region program. Details coming soon.

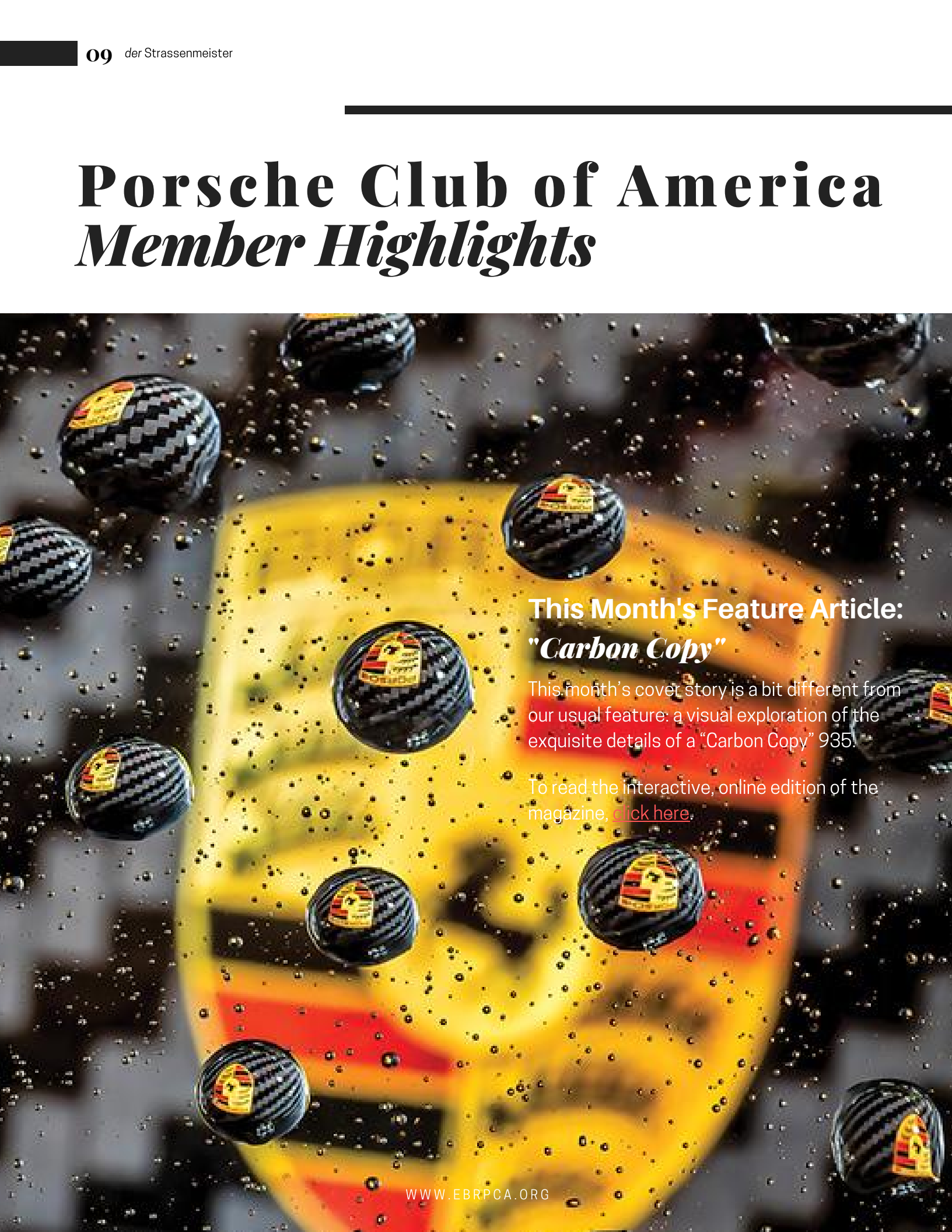

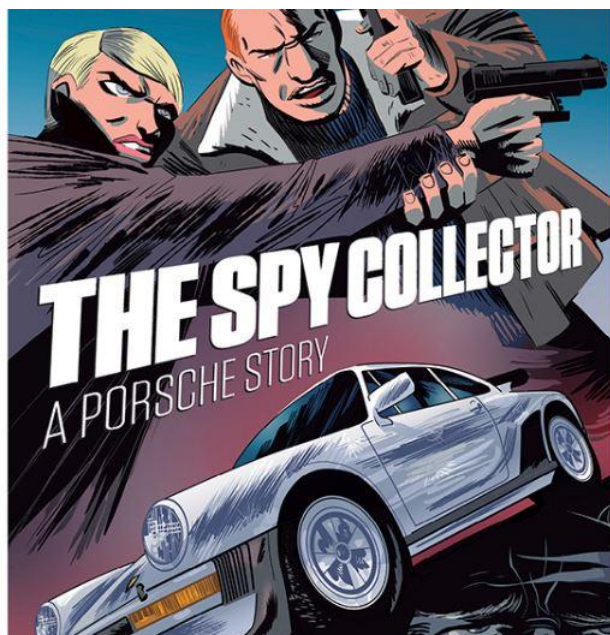

PCA Event Changes Reminder

PCA National has mandated that we begin use IMMEDIATELY of the [Communicable Disease Spectator and Participant Release Waiver](#) for ALL events, meetings, etc. as liability protection for PCA.

If you are planning to attend an in-person event, please print and complete the attached form. If you are not able to do so, please advise the event host that you need a waiver form to complete.

On the top of the form, where it states FILL IN TRACK/FACILITY NAME ABOVE, please write in "All PCA events." This will suffice for all events held May 15, 2020 through May 15, 2021.

Below are instances when this document **needs** to be on file:

- A moving car event
- Every moving car event, with a controlled entry point
- At a restaurant sit down dinner
- Social events at a venue

Please note: the document is **not needed** at open venue events, such as Cars and Coffee and Concours.



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
