Tom has been a PCA member since 2002. He currently owns two Porsche's: a 3.2 911 Carrera and Euro 2.7 911 Targa.

What is your favorite thing about owning a Porsche?

Driving them on our curvy, undulating country roads and road tripping in the vintage 911's. My cars have been on camping/fishing trips to Vermont, upstate New York and the Alleghenies in Pennsylvania. I am headed to the southern Appalachian mountains next! I love meeting other people that are passionate about Porsche at cars and coffee/hpde days too.

What is your favorite memory with your vehicle?

That's a tough one, there are so many. Probably taking the Targa back and forth through literally all the mountain passes in Vermont circa 2002, after I rescued her off the farm.

What is your favorite Porsche model?

959 - I used to go to Jeff's Motors after school at Central and drool on the one they had on the floor.

If you could drive any Porsche for a single day, which would you choose? Why?

959 - I briefly held an SCCA Pro Rally license and still dream of doing Paris-Dakar or Peking-Paris. The 959 was designed to dominate Group B rally racing, but the series was cancelled while they were still finalizing the engineering. Too bad, would have been awesome to see the 959 go toe to toe with the Audi Quattro!

TOM SHARED: "My story acquiring my first 911 (which I still drive all the time) is kind of funny. I had just got let go, along with all the other CCM employees at our facility, and was looking for a job in the newspaper when I saw an ad for an older 911 Targa. I'd been a 911 nut since I was a kid, when the RUF yellow bird won the top speed shoot out in 1987 Road and Track, and I had time on my hands so I called the guy and went to check it out. It was sitting under a tarp looking a bit sad, but the test drive went ok. At the wise old age of 26, I had this severance check in hand and figured jobs were dime a dozen, so I pulled the trigger. Since then I've done a complete mechanical restoration but left the chips and scratches on the outside while driving her over 30,000 miles."

PORSCHE WAS FOUNDED on a bedrock of four-cylinder engines. For the first 16 years of its existence, anything other than a horizontally opposed four-cylinder was foreign to Stuttgart, and virtually every Porsche competition success prior to the 906 was achieved with a four-cylinder car. Yet today, buyers have all but heeded the brilliant 718 Boxster/Cayman out of the marketplace, simply because it's a four and not a six. This isn't a new thing; the first incarnation of the 911 is brilliant but six back in 1964 seems to have made life technically difficult for any four-cylinder Porsche that followed. The 718's chilly reception notwithstanding, few cars have been more maligned over the years than the 912E and its successor, the 924. But were they actually bad cars, or did not-a-911-ism and four-cylinder prejudice deal them a particularly harsh blow?
