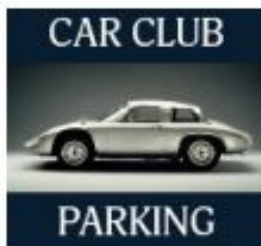

Join us at *Porsche Parade*

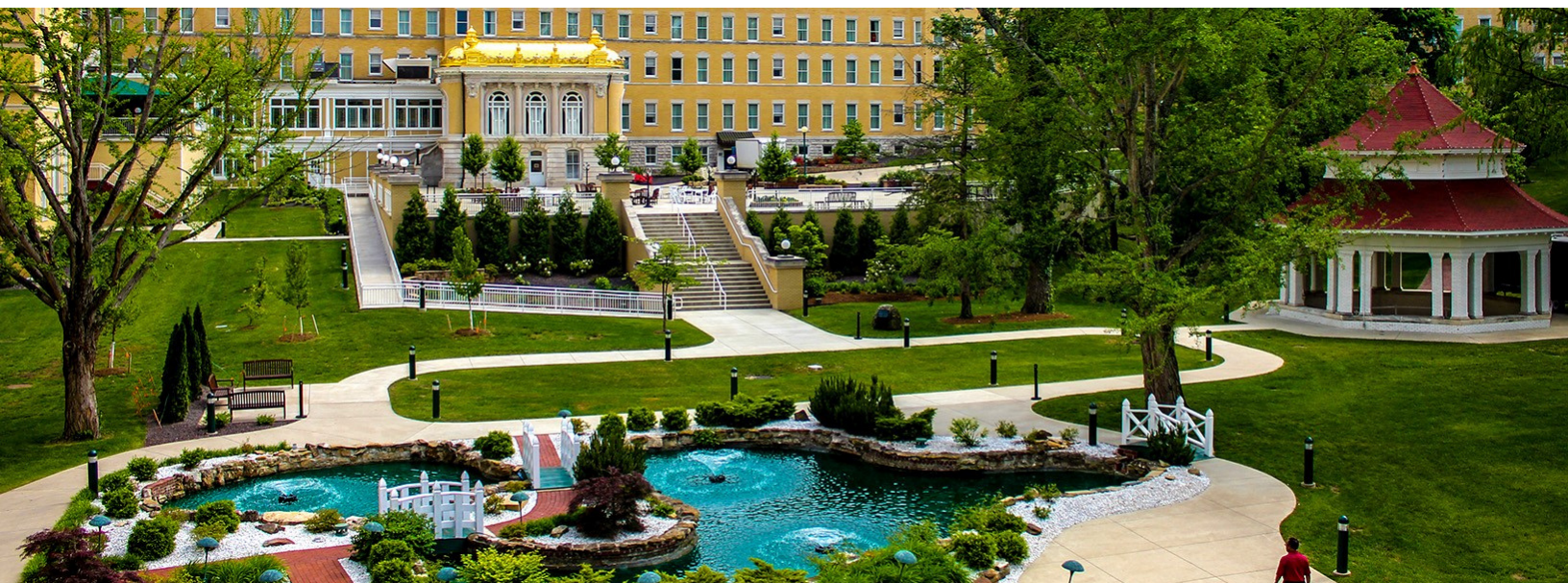

Porsches on the Mac II

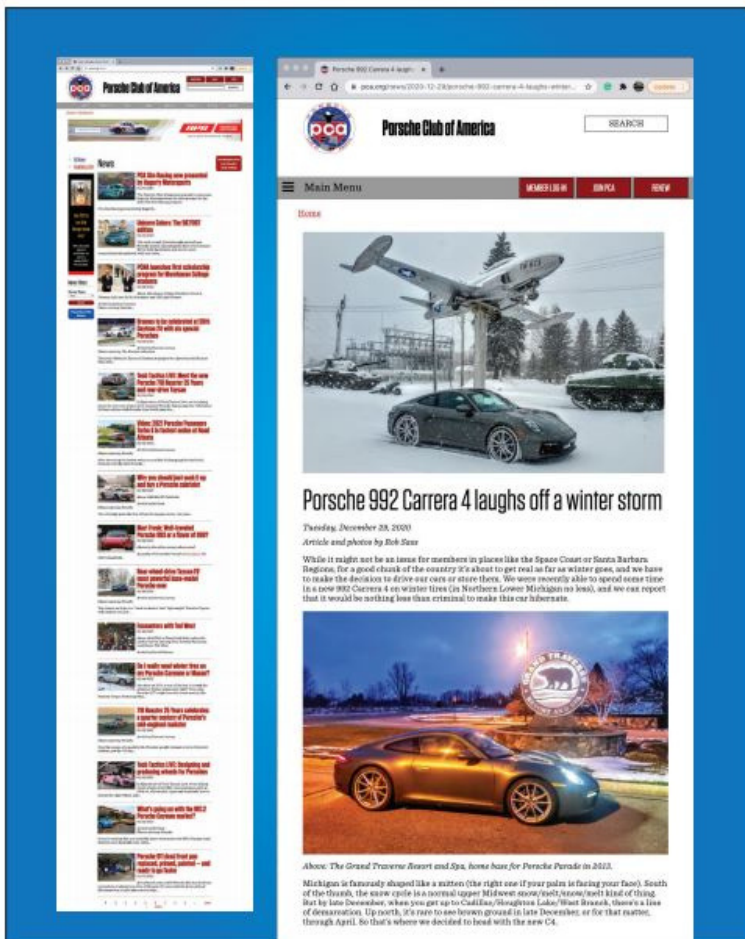

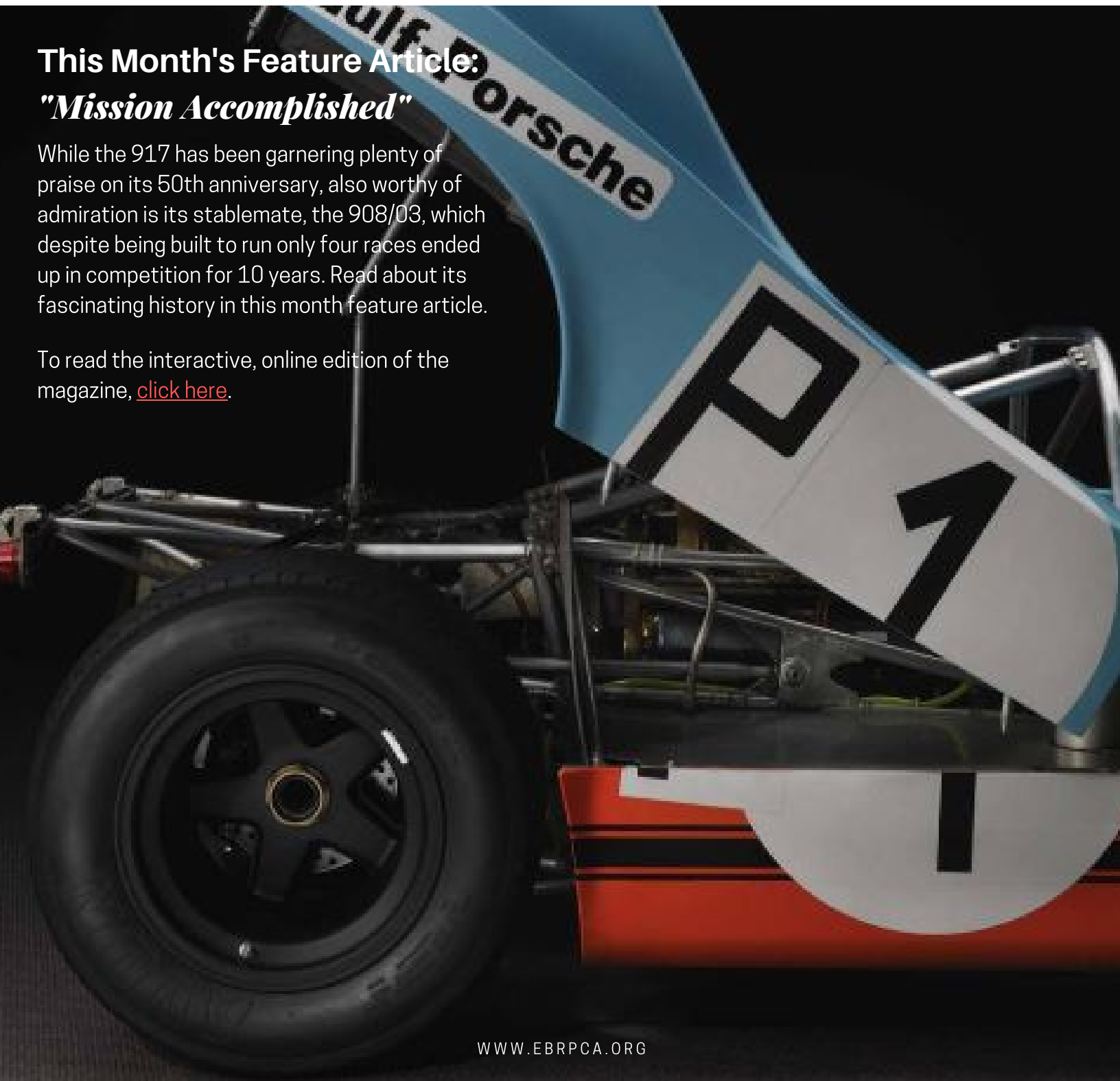
