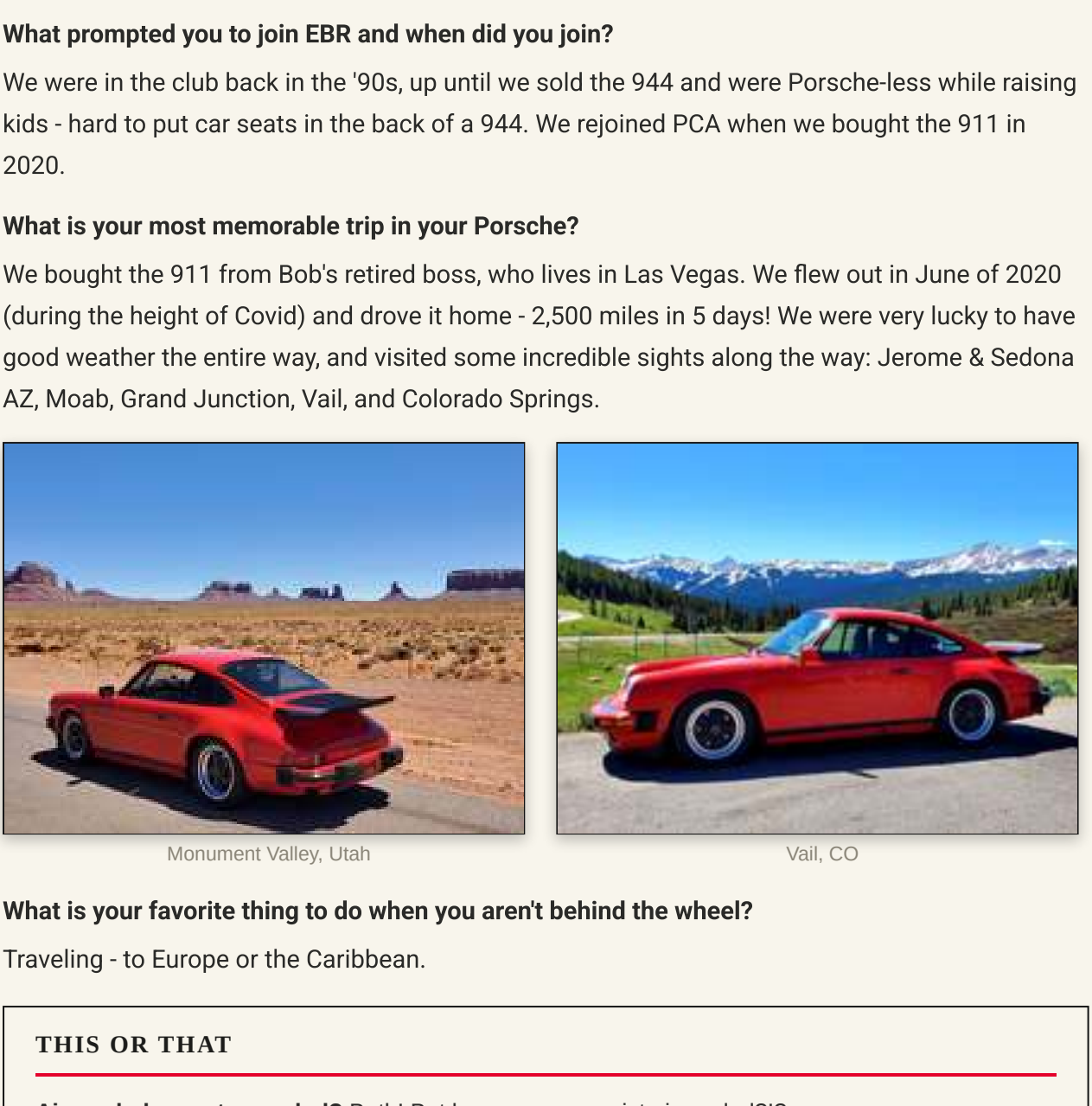

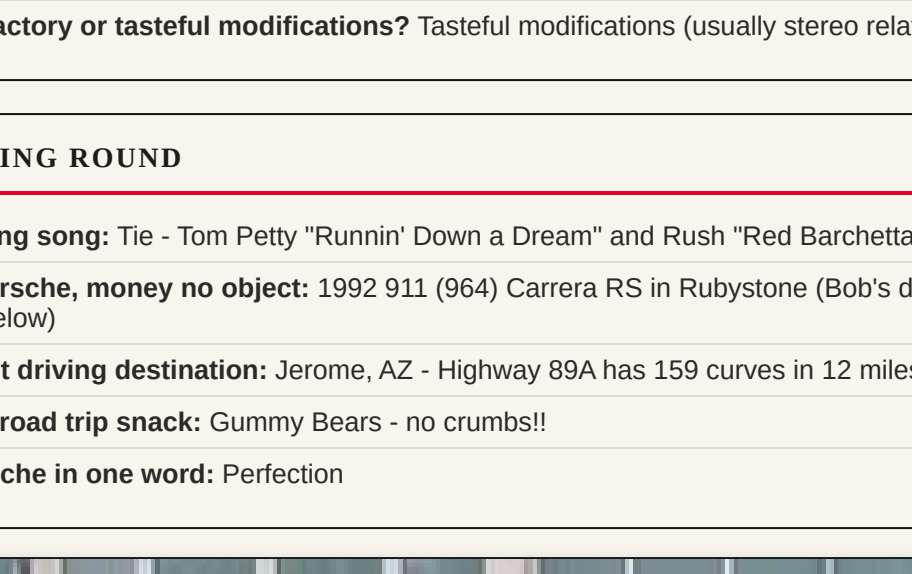

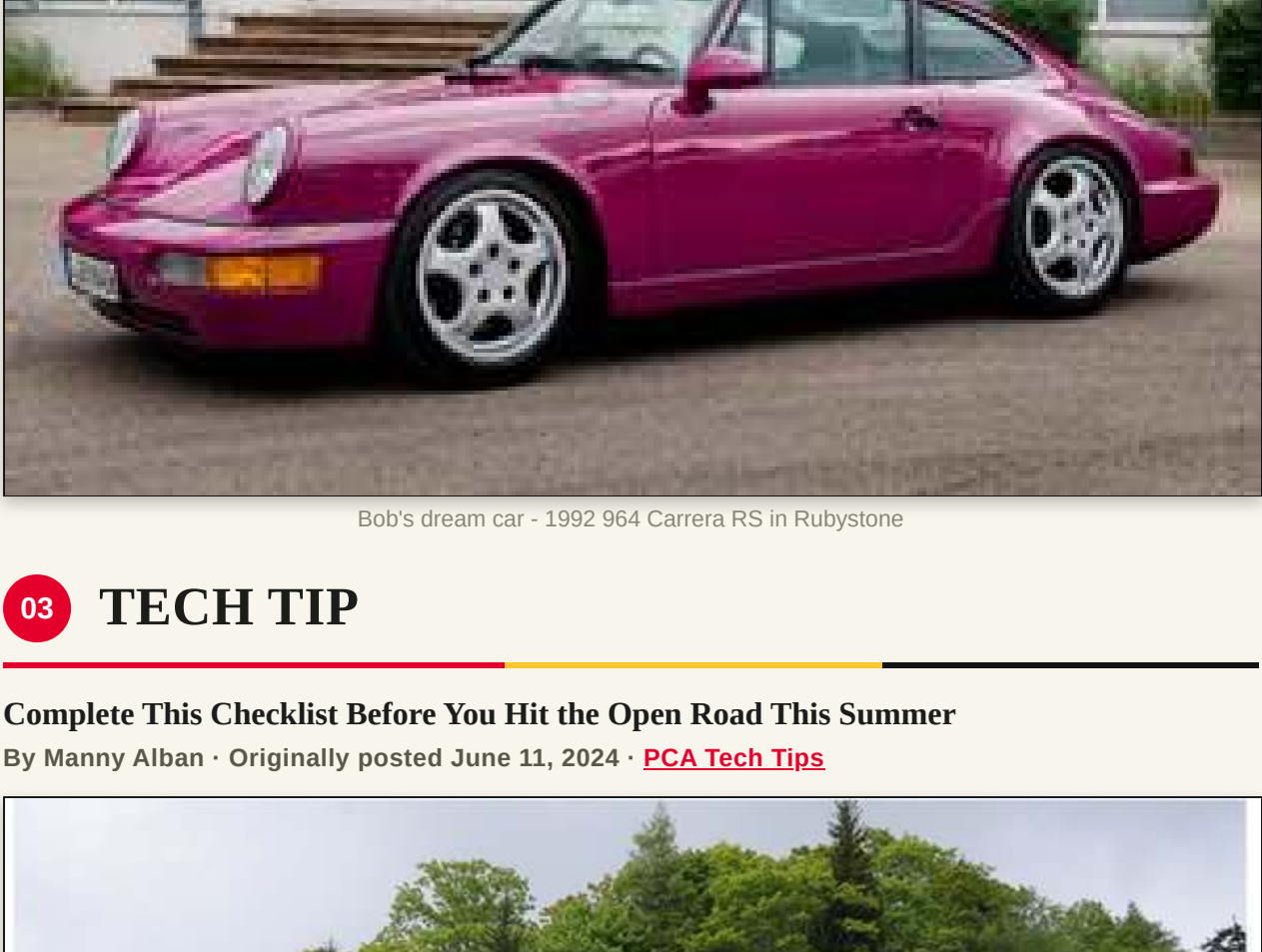


What was the first Porsche you ever drove or owned? What do you drive now?

Is your current Porsche(s) your dream car or are you still chasing?

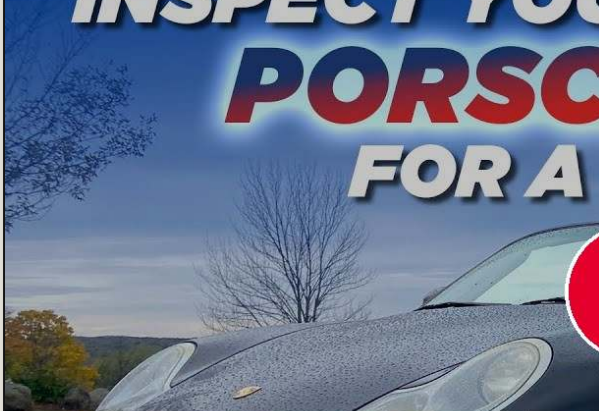
An early 1990's 964 in Amazon Green Metallic is the dream car.

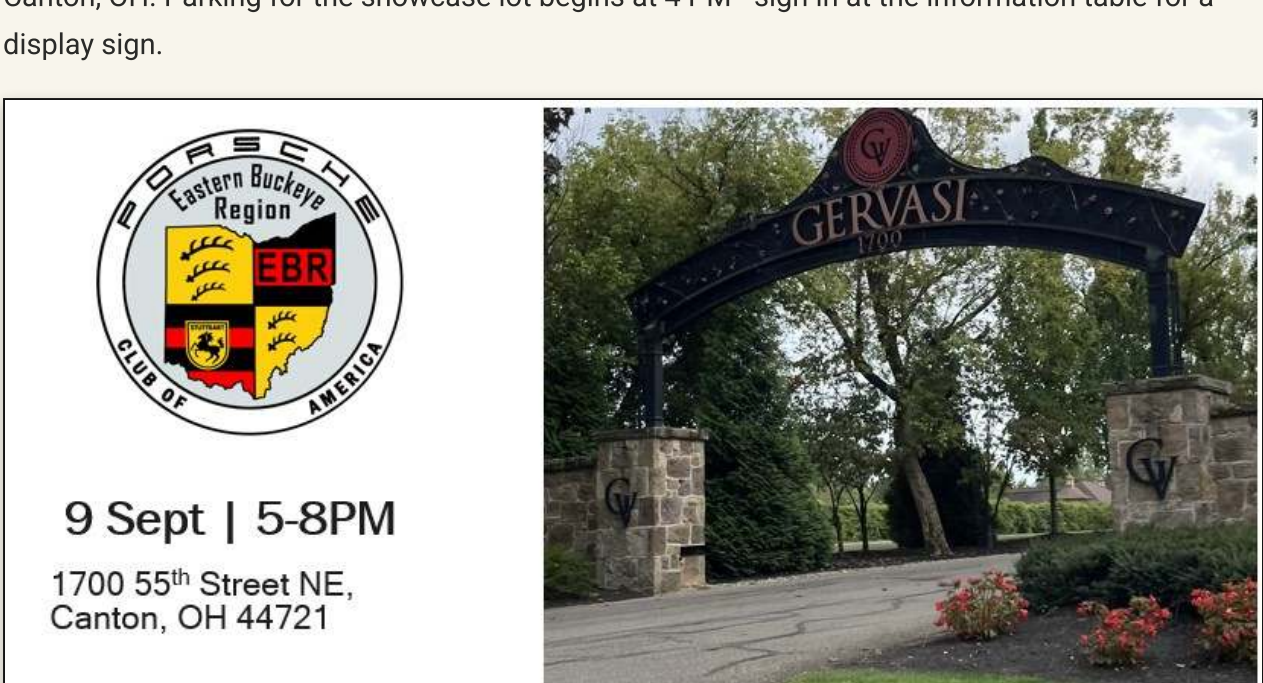

Your Porsche in one word: Perfection

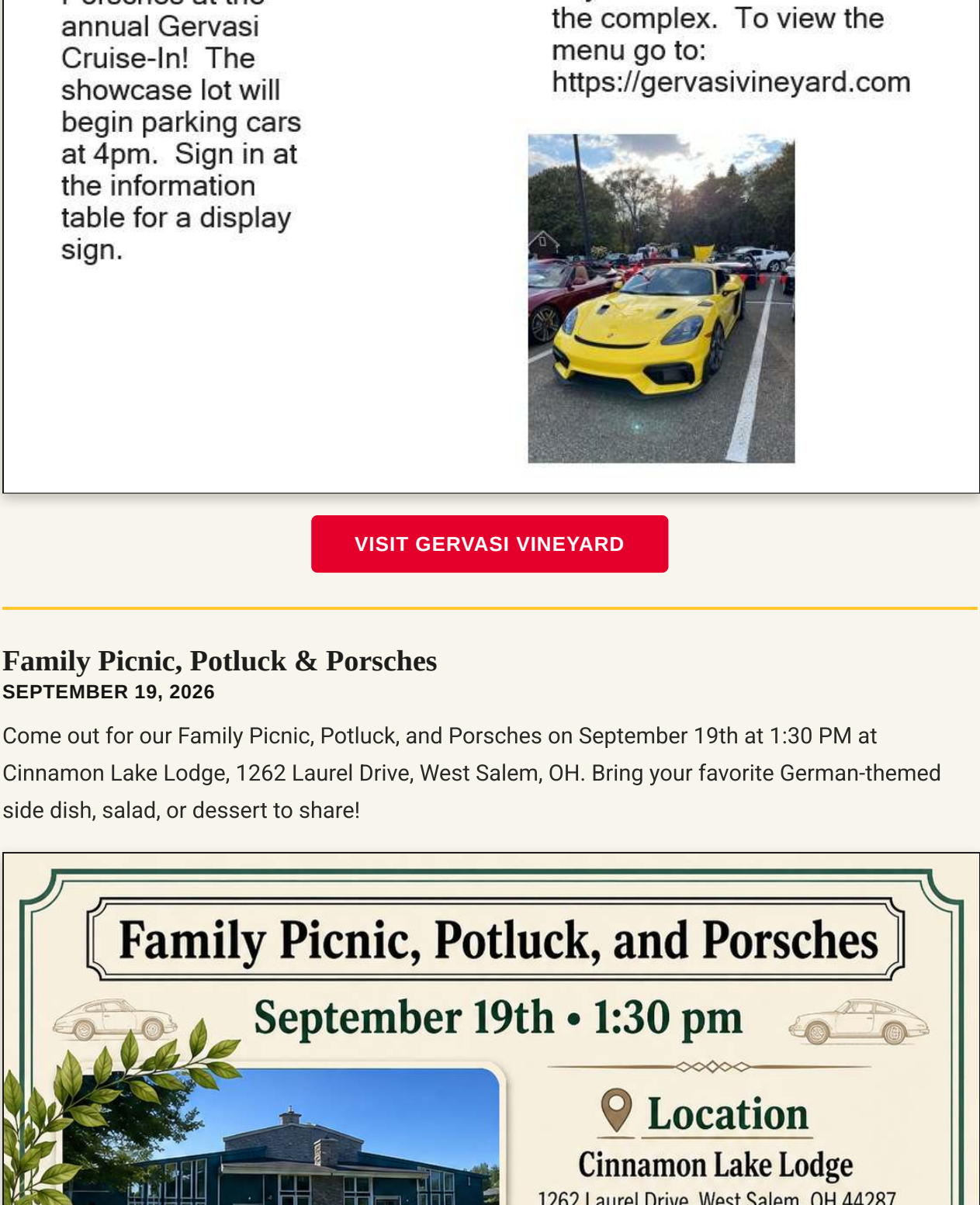
